DISCUSSION ITEM

1. There was a discussion about roles and responsibilities of the members of the Commission. 2. The group reviewed Chapter 2.62 of the Municipal code and made the following suggested changes:
 - 2.62.020 d.- Julian suggested that interview be done by the mayor

 - 2.62.050- need to add a section to have a secretary.
 - 2.62.070 e- change student town hall to outreach activity.

 - c. Secretary- there were no nominations at this time.

 - Create a public awareness campaign.
