1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting of **Tuesday November 16, 2021** was called to order by Chair Henry Mackenroth at 6:00 PM via a virtual Zoom Meeting.

Committee members present included Ray Atkinson, Cedomir Jesic, Bob LaSalle, Henry Mackenroth, Tim Morgan, Ben Simmons, and Tim Wuest. Savannah Ovaldia was absent.

Staff members present included John Lewis, Public Works Director, Vance Walker, Assistant Public Works Director, and Kim Davis, Senior Administrative Assistant.

2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Mr. Atkinson **moved to approve** the minutes of the **October 19, 2021**, and it carried **unanimously** by the following vote: Atkinson, Jesic, LaSalle, Mackenroth, Morgan, Simmons, and Wuest.

5. NEW BUSINESS/DISCUSSION ITEM

a. Public Works Report

Major points were as follows:

- Mr. Lewis talked about the Tolling Values. He said the things that we are going to talk about are specifically related to the adopted 2013 TSP goals. Mr. Lewis said the Oregon Legislature passed House Bill 2017 – Keep Oregon Moving. He said this House Bill would help manage congestion and generate revenue. Mr. Lewis talked about the TAC values as they are related to tolling.
- Mr. Lewis gave an update on the All Roads Transportation Safety (ARTS), which is a grant that is safety focused. He talked about the Beaver Creek Road Corridor Improvements that will be funded by this grant.

- Mr. Lewis talked about the City Commission Goal #2, which is to invest in current and future capital needs for safe, sustainable infrastructure and City services. He talked about prioritizing projects in the Transportation Master Plan.
- Mr. Lewis gave an update on the City-Wide Traffic Counts. He said the 2020 traffic counts were pushed out a year due to Covid. He said the City hires a company to do the traffic counts.

7. FUTURE AGENDA ITEM

- Tim Morgan would like to continue the conversation about the speed limit on HWY 213.
- Tim Wuest talked about the new addition of housing that is going to go in off Holcomb Blvd. and the amount of traffic will increase on Holcomb Blvd. from that addition.
