



October 19, 2021

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**

The Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting of **Tuesday October 19, 2021** was called to order by Chair Henry Mackenroth at 6:00 PM via a virtual Zoom Meeting.

Committee members present included Ray Atkinson, Cedomir Jesic, Bob LaSalle, Henry Mackenroth, Tim Morgan, Ben Simmons, and Tim Wuest. Savannah Ovaldia was absent.

2. **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

a. **Public Works Report**

Major points were as follows:

- Mr. Walker gave an update on the lighting at the Transit Center. He said the damaged lights are set to be replaced in October.
- Mr. Lewis gave an update on the Oregon City/West Linn joint work sessions. He said there were two work sessions, one on the September 28th and one on September 30th. Mr. Lewis said ODOT attended the meeting on September 28th.
- Mr. Lewis talked about increased school traffic related to parent drop-off. He said the City has been in communication with the School District about the issues and talking about possible solutions for the increased traffic.

- Mr. Lewis gave an update on Molalla Avenue and said things are on track and signals should be turned on soon.
- Mr. Lewis talked about the Rapid Flashing Beacon Project. He said aside from the three going in on Molalla Avenue, there is one going in on Linn Avenue, and two going in on Holcomb Blvd.
- Mr. Lewis said the 2021 Pavement Maintenance Utility Projects are winding down.
- Mr. Walker talked about the In-House paving projects that were done in 2021.
