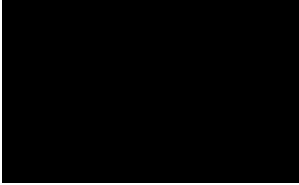

Dear Mayor Lyles Smith and City Commissioners,

With both of the Oregon City special elections behind us, I have been thinking intently about my role in local government moving forward. Applying for this vacancy on the city commission was not a part of my post-graduation plan, but after some people reached out and encouraged me to apply, I began to give this prospect some thought. I was humbled by their kind words, but immediately remembered that my age and position in life presented some serious hurdles to success.

As I reflected more, I realized I was selling myself short. I am in the middle of working my third session at the Oregon State Legislature and have a strong grasp of the issues. I have pre-existing relationships with many of our regional elected officials from having been involved in local government since high school. My studies at Willamette University in policy and communications have given me the necessary skills to do the job effectively. I have demonstrated my commitment to bridging divides as a community organizer. And most importantly, I am a product of Oregon City. I was raised here since my adoption from South Korea, graduated with honors from our public schools just a few years back, and have attended church here for as long as I can remember. While I am not ignorant to the fact that appointing a soon-to-be college graduate, who is not even old enough to drink, may seem risky, I believe my proven track record of advocacy and involvement, coupled with my knowledge and love of our community, makes me uniquely suited to jump straight into the job on day one. It has been a pleasure working with the four of you over the course of the last year; I would be honored to continue doing so on the other side of the dais.
