March 15, 2022

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting of **Tuesday March 15, 2022** was called to order by Chair Henry Mackenroth at 6:00 PM via a virtual Zoom Meeting.

Committee members present included Ray Atkinson, Bruce Fries, Tim Morgan, Ben Simmons, and Miles Tatch. Henry Mackenroth and Cedomir Jesic were absent.

Staff members present included Vance Walker, Assistant Public Works Director, Dayna Webb, City Engineer, and Jayson Thornberg, Transportation Maintenance Manager.

2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Mr. Atkinson **moved to approve** the minutes, and was **seconded** by Mr. Morgan of the **February 15, 2022**, and it carried **unanimously** by the following vote: Aye: Atkinson, Fries, Morgan, Simmons, and Tatch.

3. AGENDA ANALYSIS

5. NEW BUSINESS/DISCUSSION ITEM

a. Public Works Report

Major points were as follows:

- Dayna Webb, Oregon City Engineer, gave an update on the Trillium Park Drive Project. She gave a schedule update for the project. Ms. Webb talked about what they have done with the project up to date.
- Vance Walker, Assistant Public Works Director, gave an update on the Frontier Parkway traffic and speed concerns. Mr. Walker said he and John Lewis, Public Works Director, met with Matt Dale, Frontier Parkway resident, about the concerns of speeding and traffic in the neighborhood. He said they talked about traffic calming measure but didn't come up with a concrete solution. He said Mr. Dale was going to take the options back to the

Neighborhood Association and get back to Mr. Walker and Mr. Lewis.

- Jayson Thornberg, Transportation Maintenance Manager, shared the 2021 Pavement Maintenance Utility Fee Report. He briefly talked about the projects that were completed in 2012. He said they are looking at about the same numbers for the 2022 projects.

- Mr. Atkinson wanted to know if the TAC would be interested in discussing the Climate Friendly Equitable Communities Rule Making Process.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A representative from Clackamas County will be in attendance to present an update on the South End Road Landslide Repairs.

BACKGROUND:

In order to repair and stabilize South End Road which was damaged in March 2017 as a result of heavy rains, Clackamas County will be closing the roadway to vehicles and pedestrians, from May to November 2022. Background



Damage from heavy rains in Spring 2017

- Temporary repairs in summer 2017
- Geotechnical exploration and landslide monitoring over the last couple of winters to identify solutions to stabilize slope





Project area



What we'll be doing

Improving safety

- Build two retaining walls to prevent future slide activity on the embankment along the north side of South End Road
- North project limits will extend to soil nail embankment stabilization project performed in 2007 (shown in photo).





Timeline

- Design: Spring 2019 - July 2021
 - 30%, 60%, 90% milestones
 - Work to minimize impacts to adjacent properties
- Right of way (ROW): February 2021 - August 2021
 - Process
 - ROW staff contact property owners with permanent and temporary construction easement impacts
 - Staff will follow the ROW acquisition process including sending General Information Notice (GIN) letters, independent appraisal of property acquisition and damages, negotiations, and payment for ROW and easement acquisitions
- Oregon City Land Use Process: April 2021 - August 2021
 - Type 2 and 3 Variance Application (Geotechnical Hazards Retaining Wall Ht.)
- Construction: April/May 2022 - December 2023

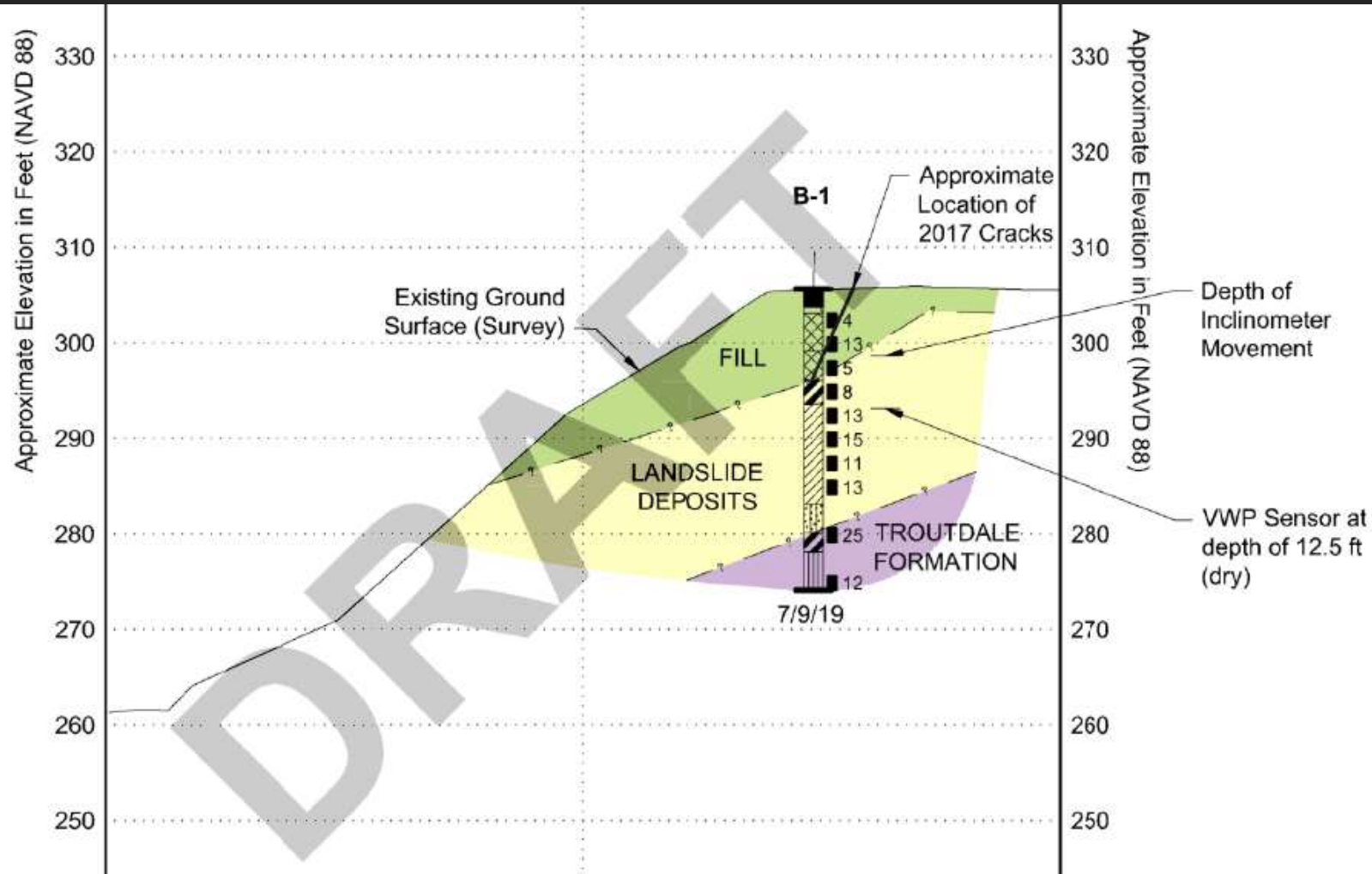

Funding: \$4.6 million

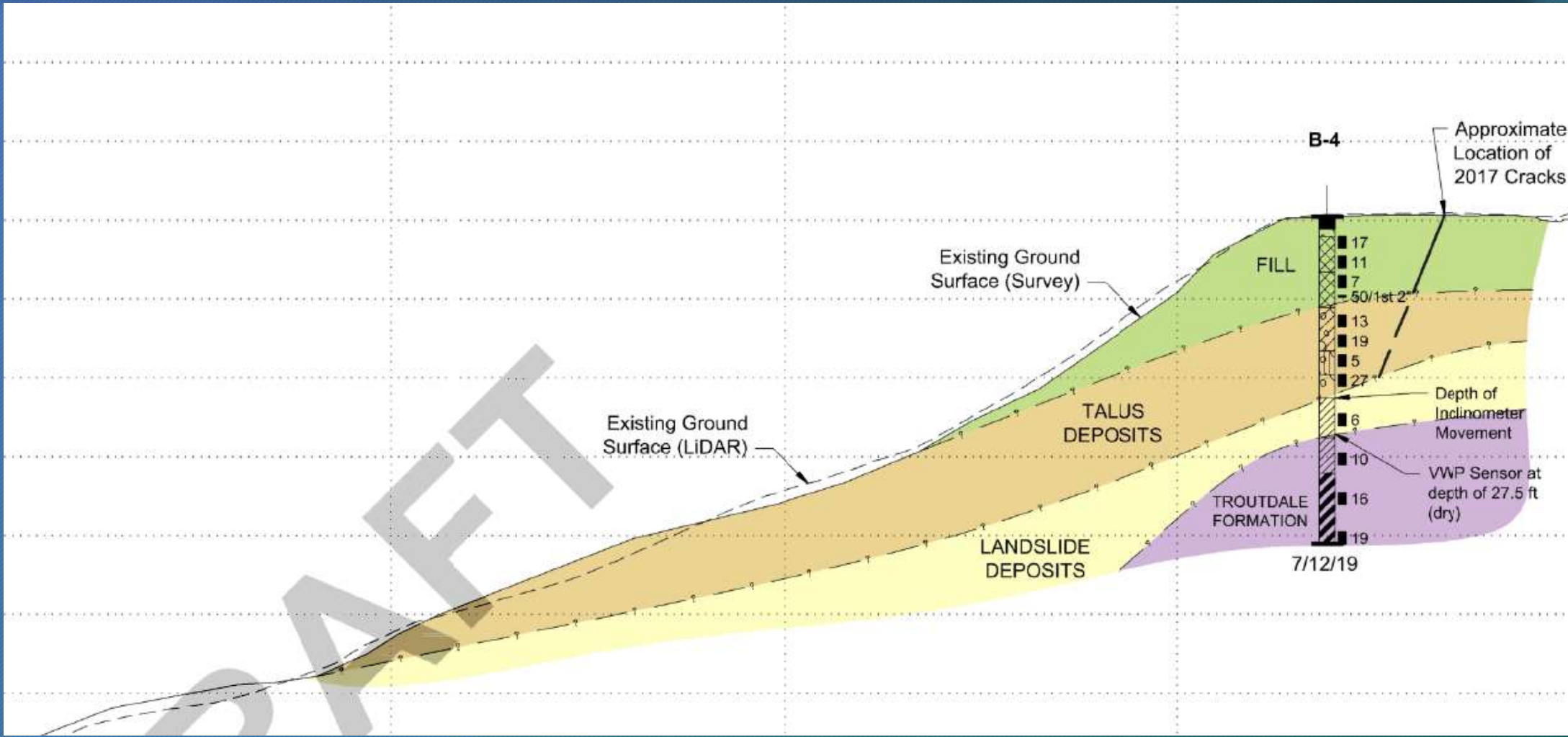


- \$4 million: Federal emergency relief program funds
- \$600,000: County Road Funds

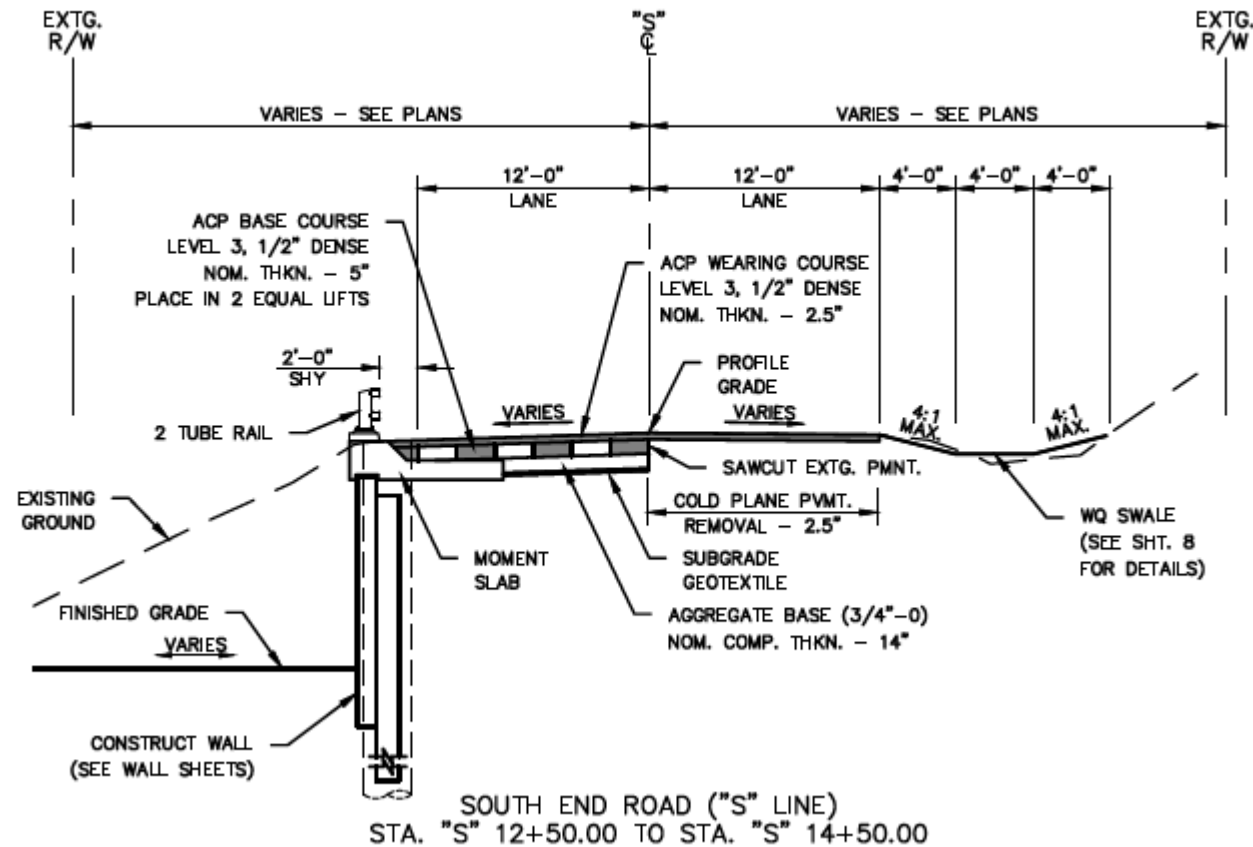
Cross Section of Landslide Geology - Part 1



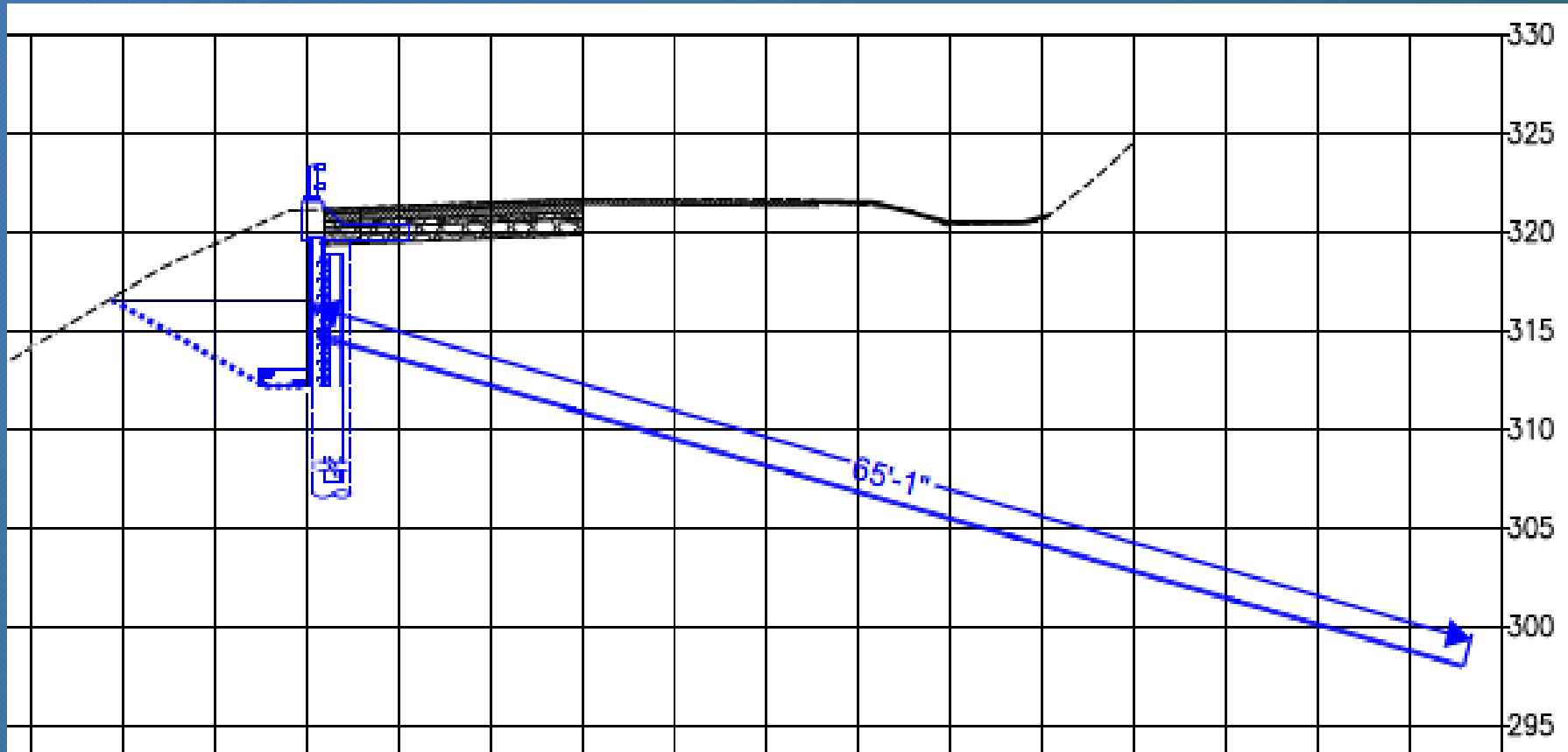
Cross Section of Landslide Geology - Part 2



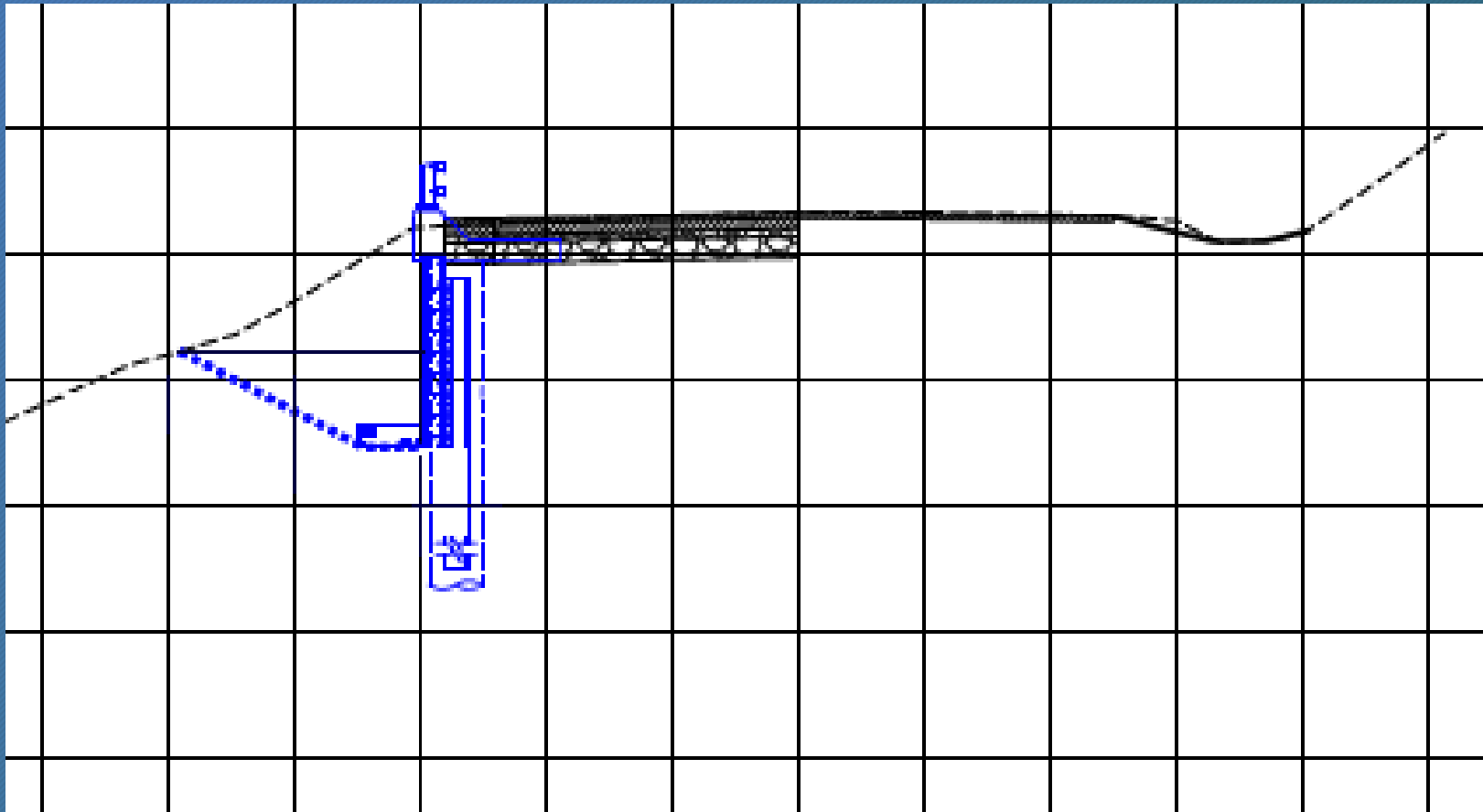
Roadway Cross Section Example
