CONVENE SPECIAL MEETING AND ROLL CALL

Commission President Rocky Smith convened the meeting at 5:31 PM.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Interviews for the Oregon City Budget Committee

Kattie Riggs, City Recorder, mentioned that candidates Timothy Rasch and Jonathan Deyoe had withdrawn.

The questions that were asked of the candidates were:

2. What skills, connections, resources, and expertise do you have to offer and are willing to contribute to the budget committee?
3. Explain any worries or concerns you have about joining the budget committee (including, but not limited to, any time constraints or scheduling hurdles)?
4. Do you have personal aspirations that could be enhanced by serving on the budget committee?
5. What is your experience working with budgets?
6. Do you have any ideas to help the City stretch funds or create new revenue?
7. What is the role of the budget committee and how is the role determined?
8. What are the most important financial issues facing the City and why are they important?

2. Interviews for the Oregon City Enhancement Grant Program Committee

Kattie Riggs, City Recorder, mentioned that Jonathan Deyoe had also withdrawn from the Enhancement

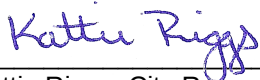
Grant Program Committee candidate pool.
