1. CONVENE MEETING AND ROLL CALL

Commission President Rocky Smith called the meeting to order at 3:33 PM.

2. GENERAL BUSINESS

2a. Resolution No. 21-12, Extending the Declaration of a State of Emergency in Oregon City due to Winter Storm Destruction

Commission President Rocky Smith Jr. had declared a state of emergency on Sunday, February 14, 2021 and it needed to be extended, so the resolution before the Commission would extend it until March 18, 2021.

Tony Konkol, City Manager, discussed the winter storm events, City staff responses, power outages, and the damages sustained in the City. He also cautioned the residents about possible dangers and the two locations that the City opened for debris drop-off.

Commissioner Lyles Smith asked for updates on Meals on Wheels and local hospitals. Mr. Konkol provided a Meals on Wheels update and did not have an update on hospitals. Commissioner Lyles Smith asked what residents should do with their debris and tree limbs if they can't take their debris to a drop-off location.

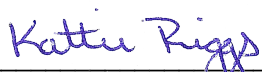
Motion made by Commissioner McGriff, seconded by Commissioner Lyles Smith to approve Resolution No. 21-12. The motion passed by the following vote:
