Each speaker is given 3 minutes to speak. Representatives of neighborhood associations may be given 5 minutes to speak if requested. As a general practice, the City Commission does not engage in discussion with those making comments. Complaints shall first be addressed at the department level prior to addressing the City Commission. Electronic presentations are permitted but must be delivered to the City Recorder 48 hours in advance of the meeting.
